

The State of New Hampshire requires that all enrollees in a certified driver education program have an eyesight screening before they get behind the wheel for the first time. This screening is not in any way to be considered a thorough eye exam. That is not the intent. We want to make sure that all enrollees can see well enough to drive and can also pass the minimum visual acuity test when they go to the DMV to take their driving test. NH law states that you must be able to see with a visual acuity of 20/40 with both eyes, and if legally blind in one eye, a vision designation of 20/30 in the other eye.
